The training will help organisations to develop and improve a volunteer programme that can

- attract and recruit more volunteers
- supervise, support and engage volunteers more efficiently, and
- improve their capacity building in volunteer management

SO WHY DO WE NEED MENTORS?

We often find that even after trainings, organisations might still be lack of confidence and encouragement to apply what they learn into practice. Therefore, we are looking for mentors that can provide further support to organisations so they can apply the training knowledge to the specific needs of their organisations.

Requirements

- Experience in volunteer management or leadership
- Commitment of 2 hours/week for a period of 3 or 6 months during January to June 2019
- Flexibility around mentoring outside of business hours.

This mentoring programme can be an excellent professional development opportunity and a great way for you to use your skills and experience to give back to the community and help make an impact to these limited resource organisations.
